

Students admitted into the Academic Studies (XACP) are encouraged to dedicate themselves to perform very well in their UTSA classes to achieve the highest possible Overall University GPA. Students in Academic Studies (XACP) will be reviewed before registration each academic semester (Fall and Spring) and will be accepted to the Construction Science and Management major (CSM) based on their grade point average (GPA) and number of available seats.
